

MAF Dalkia to support Dubai International Energy Conservation Measures

Dubai International is the second busiest airport in the world, receiving more than 65 million passengers per year and transporting more than 2.5 million tonnes of cargo annually. MAF Dalkia's contract will oversee a total of 2 million sqm area, comprising 12 facilities.
